- Work cannot begin on this project until the Natural Areas Staff receives and signs a copy of your Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook pages including:
 - 'Project Description'
 - 'Project Details' with approval signatures
 - 'Materials List'

We will not provide a 'letter of project acceptance' until we have seen this document. You may fax it to us and then we will provide the letter or you may deliver or mail us a copy to sign and return to you.

- The Eagle candidate is responsible for making sure all necessary indemnification forms are completed before site work begins. One adult form and one youth form are included with this packet. You may make as many copies as you need. These forms must be submitted as they are accumulated during the project to the Natural Areas staff
- The Eagle candidate must contact Natural Areas Staff monthly to report progress. Failure to do this may result in termination of the Eagle project and the awarding of the project to another individual/group.
- The Eagle Scout should provide the staff with information about workdays on site at least two weeks before the workday – especially if special access or conditions prevail.
- Unless specified in the signed Project Planning pages of the Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook (and based on discussion with and approval of the Natural Areas staff), any damage to flora, fauna, facilities or other park assets will result in termination of the Eagle Project and no final project approval will be granted.
- When the project is complete, the Natural Areas Staff will inspect the final product and report to the scout regarding the acceptability of the work.
- If further work is needed, the scout should accomplish the work and the Natural Areas staff will re-inspect as needed
- Upon project completion, the Natural Areas Staff must receive a final project report with work accomplished and total volunteer hours contributed to the project. No 'letter of approval of completion of the project' will be issued until we have a signed copy of the final report in hand.
